Te Runanga, (The Meeting House), was built in 1903 and lies at the heart of the 50 acre garden. It became the social centre of the nearby spa facilities. A gracious villa with wide verandas on three sides it's perfectly positioned to enjoy the expansive views across the Gardens to the city's two most iconic heritage buildings, the Tudor styled Bathhouse Museum and contrasting Spanish Mission architecture of The Blue Baths.
